Fagioli PSC performed the loadout of two living quarter modules in Gothenburg, Sweden for Pharmadule Emtunga.

Our scope of works for the 1st loadout of the 2200 tonne Kristin L.Q. included:

- The supply of 138 axles of SPMT transporters to site
- Move the structure 0.5km from the fabrication hall to the loadout quay
- Loadout, supply of ballast system, winches and associated engineering
- Weighing utilising eight Fagioli PSC Flat Jacks,
- Design of the seafastening grillage steelwork
- Barge supply and towage from Gothenburg to Norway

The site move was particularly challenging as the exit from the hall required a 90 degree turn with as little as 1m clearance on either side.
